Evaluation Methods Used:

A sample set of 7 screens and 25 components within Inspiration are identified to perform the audit.

The screens and components are tested with JAWS 2019 and NVDA 2020. A set of 2 random screens and 2 random components are tested using ZoomText and Dragon Naturally Speaking each. Accessibility testers performed the audit using automated tools such as Color contrast checker, keyboard-only interaction, screen readers (JAWS and NVDA), ZoomText and Dragon Naturally Speaking. Accessibility testers performed the tests with the assistive technology stated, and Inspiration 12 with Dragon Naturally Speaking was tested using an external Dragon Professional consultant. The results reflect the accessibility of a set of 7 screens and 25 components.
